

# Word – "500,000 in One Hour" "Great Change is Coming"

Re: Dramatic change

On February 26, 2005, I heard "**500,000 in one hour**" followed by "**Great change is coming.**"

If these two words go together, which seems likely, then a dramatic event will occur that, presumably, will involve 500,000 people in some manner.

*Postscript:* Since 2005, there have been many major natural disasters in the world. Here are just a few that have occurred in the month of February, as of 2011. Take note that there have been at least three natural disasters that have affected at least 500,000.

February 5-6, 2010 – One of the biggest snowstorms in US history hit Washington DC and the Mid-Atlantic States. It became known as Snowmageddon. **500,000 were reported without power.** On this same day, it was reported that the Haiti quake of January 12, 2010 left 150,000 dead with **500,000 or more homeless.**

February 10, 2010 – Chicago was hit with a big snowstorm and a 4.3 quake.

February 26, 2010 – Southern Japan was hit with a quake.

February 27, 2010 – The US Northeast was hit with a hurricane-like snowstorm.

February 27, 2010 – Chile was hit near Concepcion with 8.8 quake, the 7<sup>th</sup> largest in world history. Argentina was also hit with a 6.0 quake. **500,000 homes were reported as seriously damaged in Chile** and 5.5 million people affected.

February 22, 2011 – Christchurch, NZ was hit with a 6.3 quake. One-third of its buildings were seriously damaged.

By the way, an event did occur on February 11, 2011 that could be classified as a major (great?) change. On this date, Mubarak of Egypt was deposed from power in what was called the Egyptian Revolution, which shifted the balance of power in the Middle East and opened the door for the rise of Islamists. Footnote: The Iran Revolution occurred on February 11, 1979.

However, at this point, we have yet to see a "500,000 in one hour" event that has brought great change in the world. Or, have we, and we have simply missed it?
