“God’s Will is of No Concern to this Congress” (Commentary)

On **February 25, 2021**, the **US House of Representatives** was debating the Democrat bill titled **Equality Act**. To be sure, there is much to be concerned about in this bill, especially when it comes to the **transgender agenda** that is part of **transhumanism**, which, in turn, is part of the **global technocracy agenda**; topics I have addressed in a number of writings. However, this is not the reason for this posting—the above quote is!

[Normally, I don’t include names, but in this case, it is a necessity.]

Something astoundingly telling happened during the House floor debate as **Rep. Gregory Steube (R-FL)** voiced his concerns over this bill. We thank God for those, such as Mr. Steube, who willingly stand for righteousness in this day where unrighteousness is trying to wipe out what vestiges of righteousness remain in government. Unfortunately, his speech received no coverage from the mainstream propaganda media.

Here is a transcript of Rep. Steube’s comments:

It’s not clothing or personal style that offends God, but rather the use of one’s appearance to act out or take on a sexual identity different from the one biologically assigned by God at birth. In His wisdom, God intentionally made each individual uniquely either male or female. When men or women claim to be able to choose their own sexual identity, they are making a statement that God did not know what He was doing when He created them.

*I’m going to quote directly from Dr. Tony Evans’ commentary Bible on this passage of scripture: “Men and women equally share in bearing the image of God, but He has designed them to be distinct from and complementary toward one another. The gender confusion that exists in our culture today is a clear rejection of God’s good design. **Whenever a nation’s laws no longer reflect the standards of God, that nation is in rebellion against Him, and will inevitably bear the consequences.**”*

[At this point, Rep. Steube was interrupted by **Rep. Jerry Nadler (D-NY)** and then allowed to continue, which he did by repeating the last sentence (bold), and proceeding with ...]

And I think we are seeing the consequences of rejecting God here in our country today. And this bill speaks directly against what is laid out in scripture. Our government through this bill is going to redefine what a woman is and what a man is. It can be anyone who identifies in that gender.

Clearly, Rep. Steube was making his point about this bill from a **creationist worldview** that there is a **Creator God—one who designed the human race, based on male and female, both to be in the image of God**. It is encouraging to know that there are some in Congress who are willing to stand up for the truth, especially when it comes to the rights (i.e., standards) of our Creator. Steube’s message was crystal clear and much needed in a day in which the political left is attempting to upend and eradicate morality as we have known it, driving us toward an **amoral society** that shreds absolute truth into whatever way one wants to define truth; all the while seeking to eradicate whatever else stands in its way. This is all part of the bigger agenda, best described as **an evil caldron of global technocracy** that seeks to control and surveil every aspect of human life and, ultimately, seeks to transform the human race into something unhuman. These are very real dangers in this day, but we must not fear them.

The good news is that God, the Creator of all, is not going to allow mankind to devolve to such depths. The reason: His Son, who is the ultimate pattern of the new-creation man. Our Lord Jesus must return to this earth in order to consummate (i.e., complete) His new creation, and He will; you can count on it!

Now, to the point. Given all that the Lord has revealed to me about the current US political system to which He has taken His hammer and is pounding the political fortresses centered in Washington, DC, the interruption by Rep. Nadler is what needs to be highlighted. God’s strategy is to bring the darkness out into the open in order to shine His light upon it. Light conquers darkness!

This is what Nadler, as if possessed by an uncontrollable dark power, blasted out as he interrupted his fellow representative:

Mr. Steube, whatever religious tradition ascribes as God’s will is no concern of this Congress.

If you’re not stunned by this outburst, you should be. We couldn’t ask for a better illustration of the battle that is underway in our day. It was as if the darkness in this man could not refrain from reacting angrily upon hearing the righteous truth being spoken.

Take note that Nadler rejected God’s will, regardless of any religion (Christian or otherwise) that claims there is a God who has a will that matters to humanity. In essence, Nadler declared that man’s will runs Congress, which is actually a true statement for those who are in power in this day. Inherent in this rejection is a clear rejection of God’s will, as if to say: *God is not welcome in this Congress. We reject His laws (or: standards). We know best and will do as we please.* This is the voice of “the kingdom of the world”. It is a very clear rejection of the kingdom of God.

Do you know what results when man rejects God in this way? It’s called **lawlessness**. In a perverted sort of irony, Nadler is the **chair of the House Judiciary Committee**. It is quite telling that this rejection of God’s law came from one who wields much over-sight of judicial matters for our nation. **Stated bluntly: a lawless one has oversight over matters of law.** This is how far the government of our nation has fallen! However, we are not alone; many nations have gone down this same path.

This should remind us of the ancient nation of Israel that went down a similar path. In like fashion, we could say their motto was *In God We Trust* as their leaders invoked *God bless Israel*. Sound familiar? In case you missed God’s judgment of this nation, then I suggest you read their history from 66-70 AD when God sent the Roman army into Judea, bringing about the total destruction of Jerusalem and Herod’s temple, thus essentially ending biblical Judaism. They never thought such a thing could happen to them. After all, God was on their side (as they thought), for they were “chosen”.

However, Nadler’s statement goes much further than this, for he offers no pretention over the ground on which he and others like him stand. His ground is anti-God or anti-Christ. It is a most serious matter when

a nation, which was raised up by God, later rejects their God. Only God knows how deep and wide this rejection runs, but it is a sign of some serious rot within our government that, left to grow, will infect the whole, just like leaven.

Again, the good news is that God’s consuming fire stops the leaven. Fire gives forth light. As the Lord has revealed to me, He is exposing the darkness in our nation and this is an example of Him doing just that. Each day, now, the evil heart of man is on full display. Even greater good news is the fact that the Lord is in this battle of light versus darkness. As the Lord presences Himself in the battle, the dark powers that drive men are themselves driven mad by His light, and this manifests in what is best described as **derangement** or **depravity** (i.e., confusion, madness, insanity, lunacy, corruption [especially of morality], degeneracy...). However, there is a positive side to this in that this darkness is becoming more and more transparent, for all to see—no longer hidden in the shadows.

On a universal level, Nadler’s words are a sign of the kingdom of this world that is about to get a shock as it is conquered by the Kingdom of the Son of God’s love. **Let’s not forget that love conquers all.** So, take heart; there is good news in this. **Light conquers darkness. Jesus is the Light of the world. He is the Conqueror!**

Finally, let’s not forget that we are called to be His **lights in the world**. We are victorious in the one who loves us! With this in mind, we are to be **peacemakers**.

Footnote:

I have alluded to this in other writings, but we must see what is transpiring in DC as much more than a political battle. It’s easy to get caught up in the politics of the day as people are seemingly forced to take a side in the battle, generally identified as left (blue) or right (red). Every time we are told it is our patriotic duty to vote, we are being told to take a side. Every time a cry goes up that people are being disenfranchised if they can’t vote, we are being told everyone must be allowed to take a side. Choose one or the other is your solemn duty, we are told.

However, as the Lord’s people, we are to be different from the ways of the world, including choosing sides, which in this day is more about which side is less corrupt than the other. So, the slogan goes: choose the lesser of two evils.

But, to be clear, none of what I am saying is meant to counsel Christians to vote or not to vote, or whether we should be of one party or another. That is a personal choice, as long as we realize we are engaging ourselves in the system of the world, which is the kingdom of this world. As I have emphasized many times, this requires spiritual discernment.

Far more importantly is, that as the Lord’s people, we must see that we have a much higher calling than what the world system offers us. We are to set our minds above where our Lord is seated and, when we do, one thing we will touch is our beloved Lord’s heart for oneness. The kingdom of God has no party divisions!

Part of our calling can best be summed up in this word **oneness** (or: **union**). This is a topic all unto itself that has been growing in my heart lately that I plan to write about later. Until then, the point I must stress is that we are to be one (in union) with our Lord Jesus and His body. As such, it is paramount that we seek for oneness with one another and not division over a corrupt political system that is crumbling. I stress

this point because there are articles appearing on the net highlighting the left and the right side of Christianity, embroiling it in the politics (in a very broad sense that includes all the social issues being raised through the political narrative and proposed legislation) of the day.

We must have spiritual intelligence to see through the evil rhetoric and actions of the day, to discern the spiritual significance of what is transpiring. **We must see that a battle is raging for the heart and mind of humanity, and Jesus is in this battle.** The Lord’s ground is to be our ground. His ground is life, resurrection life. AND, included in this ground is *spiritual oneness*. After all, there is only one spirit, as there is only one Lord and one Father. We are one body! Man’s ground is death. AND, this ground of death is division along so many lines that it would be impossible to list them all.

I am reminded of Moses’ last words to the sons of Israel as they were about to cross the Jordan into the land of promise.

I call heaven and earth to witness against you today, that **I have set before you life and death, the blessing and the curse. So, choose life in order that you may live**, you and your descendants...
(Deuteronomy 30:19 NASB)

Is it much different in our day as we, too, are standing at the edge of the Jordan, getting ready to be awakened by the anointing within us as the day of our transfiguration into the likeness of our Lord Jesus grows closer?

Let us choose life, the life of the one who is the Resurrection and the Life.
