SCOTUS Building Floating Down Potomac (Vision)

On **June 29, 2010**, I was praying about the United States and, frankly, trying to sort through the many things that were happening in the US then, especially on the political and economic front.

I closed my eyes and a vision came to me of the **US Supreme Court (SCOTUS) building** located in Washington DC. The building was floating down a river, and it was tilted to the right side, as if it were about to sink into the water. It floated out of my sight as it passed behind some other buildings. This occurred while the US Senate was considering the qualifications of the latest nominee for Supreme Court associate justice. The very political process by which justice nominees are vetted is a further indication of how broken the political system is. It is like children playing in a sandbox as the two parties play their power game while the nominees dance around their questions, avoiding any meaningful scrutiny.

Watching the building floating away and sinking into the water is a picture of a failed judicial system that has become political, no longer administering righteous and impartial judgment. It will only get worse as long as *Man's Day* continues. God's law requires equal and impartial justice for all. Until the kingdom of God begins to take root among the nations, man's justice will continue to be partial and unrighteous and, as we have seen, political. If our political system is corrupt, then we can expect our judicial system to be corrupt, as well. Corruption is like leaven. Once a little leaven takes hold, it rises until it corrupts the whole (1 Corinthians 5:6-8; Galatians 5:9).

The interesting thing about this vision is that the left side of the building was rising up as the right side sank. Does this mean that the left side of the political spectrum will ultimately prevail, at least for a season? Or, does it mean that the left will be the last to remain before the entire system sinks into the water? Or, does it mean that the left will ultimately bring the whole system down into the mud of the river, meaning 2010 was the beginning of the end of an impartial justice system, if there ever truly was one?
