Little Volcanoes; Upheaval; 12 Cyclones

January 5, 2012 was a particularly powerful spiritual day for me. I won't go into the details of the day, but before it began, as I was asleep during the early morning hours, I had a simple dream.

I saw small fires that looked like small volcanoes erupting all over a field.

According to scripture, the field is the world (Matthew 13:38), and volcanoes coming up from the ground most likely indicate world conflict. I believe that, at first, they will appear as small conflicts, but they will soon rise into something much greater as given in the next two dreams.

On **February 9, 2012**, I had a dream of great upheaval that seems to go along with a word I received on July 9, 1999.

The earth was physically being shaken; it was a "great upheaval." Huge fissures were forming. I was driving a vehicle and the land around was rising and falling. At one point, I was on an area that was falling as the area next to me was rising. I drove real fast up this falling land until I found stable ground above. Then I was with a group of people; we had food and shelter, but we knew that conditions were difficult, especially in other areas. Then I saw a bus load of people arrive and they looked bewildered and dazed; they were looking for help. Then some bad guys showed up who were after these people either to do them harm or to enslave them.

Later, Psalm 31:8, 24 came to me.

And You have not given me over into the hand of the enemy; You have set my feet in a large place. ... Be strong and let your heart take courage, all you who hope in the LORD. (Psalm 31:8; 24 NASB)

We need endurance, courage, and expectant hope in these days. I am seeing great upheaval of the earth, but I am continually reminded that the upheaval that the Lord will bring about is the upheaval of the kingdom of the world, that is, the kingdom of man that stands in opposition to the kingdom of God. The Stone Kingdom is crushing the great image of the beast kingdoms as seen by Daniel. This crushing involves the institutions, ideologies, philosophies, and the systems of man, the *isms*. How will Jesus bring an end to these things? Will it be by the physical sword, killing millions? No; it will by the sword of the word that comes out of His mouth.

In His right hand He held seven stars, and **out of His mouth came a sharp two-edged sword; and His face was like the sun shining in its strength.** ... From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations, and He will rule them with a rod of iron; and He treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty. ... And **the rest were killed with the sword which came from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse**, and all the birds were filled with their flesh. (Revelation 1:16; 19:15, 21; NASB)

These verses do not speak of physical death; they speak of the death of the flesh, the carnal nature of man that wants to have dominion over the earth without God and His king seated on the throne over the earth. In others words, they want to rule in the absence of God.

The voice of the LORD hews out flames of fire. (Psalm 29:7 NASB)

Therefore, thus says the LORD, the God of hosts, "Because you have spoken this word, Behold, I am making My words in your mouth fire and this people wood, and it will consume them. (Jeremiah 5:14 NASB)

Our God is a consuming fire, and He will purify all men through His fiery law, His word.

Moving on: during the early morning hours of **February 11, 2012**, I had a dream.

I was looking down on the region of the world that stretches from the Middle East to India and possibly beyond. It was as if I were looking at a map. Then, I saw cyclones (hurricanes) lined up side-by-side stretching across this land mass. Each cyclone was touching the edge of the one next to it on each side. I did not count them but was given the impression that there were 12 of these cyclones.

Cyclones most likely indicate conflict or upheaval. Will there be 12 major conflicts in this region? The number 12 also relates to government. I suspect that there will be conflict involving 12 nations in this region, stretching from Libya to India.

Take special note that one year earlier, on **February 11, 2011**, Mubarak was ousted as the leader of Egypt, which began the so-called **Egyptian Revolution**, and the **Iranian Revolution** occurred on **February 11, 1979**, thirty-two years earlier. Could this be a coincidence? No way!

I realize that many believe that we are to pray about these things in an attempt to stop them. I do not believe that this is why I have been given these words and dreams. No man can stop the conflicts that are coming. I have been called to warn and to encourage the Lord's people to look up for our redemption draws near.

It is time to draw near to the Lord, to enter into the true, relational fellowship with Him. The midnight cry is coming, but are you ready? Are you waiting for the love of your life? The days ahead may be rough ones, but we can trust our Lord. Know Him as your trust (Jeremiah 17:7).
