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What's Going On? (Commentary)

Given all that is going on in the world today, one might be left wondering what is going on and where is it all headed. Of course, the answers to these and many more questions rest pretty much on who one listens to. To be sure, with vast amounts of information flowing across the globe through the internet, one has nearly countless sources to choose from that offer commentary or opinions on the matter, that is, unless some are censored by the big tech and establishment platforms. However, even good opinions and commentaries only touch upon fragments (even if they are important ones), meaning they can only go so far. The real challenge for all of us is to sort through these fragments for the truth.

Clearly, there is a real battle, call it a *war*, going on that is being played out in a multitude of ways from the hyped-up *pandemic* (and its de-humanization and pseudo-science) to the apparent fraudulent, presidential election to the deceptively evil, globalist drive toward a *great reset*. Putting adjectives before each of these obviously reveals a conclusion or opinion on my part. No argument there.

As I have written, truth is under siege in our day, so the question is: **Where can we go to get the truth?** As the Lord's people, the answer is clear: **the spirit of the Lord**. To some, I may sound like a record stuck in a groove, but the Lord has written on my heart that we all need to awaken to the spirit of truth that resides in each one of us who are truly in Christ and Christ is in us. We are to be in union with the one who is Truth.

And as for you, the anointing which you received from Him remains within you, and there is no need for anyone to teach you. But since His anointing gives you instruction in all things – and is true and is no falsehood – you are continuing in union with Him even as it has taught you to do. And now, dear children, continue in union with Him; so that, if He re-appears, we may have perfect confidence, and may not shrink away in shame from His presence at His Coming. (1 John 2:27-28 Weymouth)

To be sure, there are many important topics in our day; however, as ones who belong to King Jesus, we need God's view of what's going on and what's at stake. We need to hear what the spirit of the Lord is saying! *He who has an ear, let him hear what the spirit says to the called-out ecclesias.*

In light of the many insights that I have received and what has been impressed on my heart, there are four intertwined levels, which could be called *battles*, in answering the question of what's going on.

The first battle involves the Creator's rights over His creation. I wrote a short piece on this titled [Kingdom of God-Creator's Rights](#). This battle is over a God-centered universe (creation) with God holding the rights to His creation versus a man-centered universe with mankind at the center of his own universe (i.e., *humanism*). At its core is a battle between God and His creation called *man* that is in rebellion.

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Rather than repeat the contents of the above piece, I want to approach this battle solely from God's triumphant perspective – specifically, His purpose for His creation that is best described as *God's ultimate purpose*. Although man might be in rebellion against God's purpose, there is really no battle, for God the Father has determined this is the way it will be. His purpose will not be thwarted and all battles against it are destined to fail. The fact is that they have already failed. The cross and the empty tomb sealed the destiny for God's creation.

Unfortunately, there do not seem to be many voices proclaiming God's purpose. Why? I'll leave this for you to answer. Frankly, it does little good to talk about a battle between God and man if we do not know what God is up to and where He is taking His creation. Given this, we need to know His ultimate purpose.

God's Ultimate Purpose

To begin, over-arching everything that is going on in the world today is God's ultimate purpose. The word *ultimate* is used in reference to our perspective only, based on scripture; however, we need to recognize that God may have a purpose that transcends even this one that He, in His infinite wisdom and love, has chosen not to reveal to us. At this point in time, all that we have to go on is what is contained in scripture, and Paul is the one who most clearly articulates God's ultimate purpose.

For God has put all things (everything) under His feet (King Jesus). But when it says "everything" (all things) is put under Him, it is obvious that He (God the Father) who puts all things under Him (King Jesus the Son) is the exception. And when everything is subject to Him, then the Son Himself will also be subject to the One (God the Father) who subjected all things to Him (Jesus the Son), **so that God may be (the) all in all.** (1 Corinthians 15:27-28 compilation)

As emphasized throughout my writings, **God's ultimate purpose is to be all in all**, and I add – **all in love and all new**. There is nothing to be added to the expression *all in all*, for it is the most comprehensive expression in all scripture, leaving nothing out. His purpose is **the all in all**. He fully intends to fill His entire creation with His character (nature) so that creation is a full expression of who and what He is. Keep in mind that the greatest essence of God, one that speaks to relationship, is love. Creation is destined to be filled with the love of God. Stated another way: creation and all of God's creations will be a full expression of love and will operate on the principle of love. There will be no exceptions.

Of course, all of this is progressively being worked out and ultimately will be consummated through God's Son, our Lord Jesus. Paul calls it a *new creation*.

Therefore, if anyone is **in (union with) Christ (Anointed, Messiah)**, **there is a new** (different kind, character, quality) **creation**; old things have passed away, and look, new things have come. (2 Corinthians 5:17 compilation)

For both circumcision and uncircumcision mean nothing; **what matters instead is a new creation.** (Galatians 6:15 HCSB [bold added])

Since the empty tomb, those in Christ are new creations, which, by the way, is God's ultimate plan for all humanity by the consummation of the ages. The first to be harvested are **the first fruits of the new creation**.

John, the apostle of love, adds another level to this purpose through his Patmos revelation.

And the One (He who is) continuously sitting upon the throne said, "Consider this! **I am continuously making (or: I am repeatedly creating) ALL THINGS (everything) NEW.**" And He is saying [to me], "Write, because these words are faithful ones (ones full of faith) and true ones." (Revelation 21:5 JM-NT [bold added])

John heard the one who is called *Faithful and True* proclaim that He is making all things new. This was and continues to be a statement of fact. The making of all things new is about transforming all creation into the new creation. Obviously, this goes beyond just humans to include all that constitutes God's creation, seen and unseen, spiritual and physical. It is about bringing all creation into perfect union and harmony with God the Father, and this is brought about in, through, by, and for His Son, who, as John tells us: ***All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being*** (John 1:3). This is quite a comprehensive statement of fact. God's plan to achieve His ultimate purpose has been and continues to be that the very one who brought everything into being is the same one who will transform all things into the new creation where everything is of God's all in all – all new and all in love.

Dear saints, it cannot be stressed strongly enough how critical it is in these days for the Lord's people to know and see and expect God's ultimate purpose. Christ Jesus is our anchor in this day of great upheaval accompanied by chaos, confusion, deception, subversion, lies, hypocrisy, tyranny, authoritarianism, and the list goes on. And, securely anchored in our Lord Jesus is God's purpose. He is God's ultimate plan and God's way into His ultimate purpose of all. Jesus is the all of God! He is our Anchor and our Victor over these great battles that are being waged in our day that will only grow in intensity until the Father brings the curtain down on the age in which we presently live. I can assure you, without hesitation, that we are in the final act of this age, much like a play.

So, this is the over-arching battle that has been in play since the fall. At its core is **man the created in rebellion against God the Creator**. All the other battles have the same core.

Battle for Humanity

Today, there is a battle raging over the human race itself. Will humans continue to be humans as God created us to be, or are we going to become some combination of the **physical, digital, and biological**, transformed into some science fiction *cyborg* – only it won't be fiction? This is what **transhumanism** is all about – transforming humans into something that is no longer truly human as God created us to be through His Son. Transhumanism is explained in [Truth Under Siege](#).

We need to go back to the book of beginnings, Genesis, to see God's purpose in creating humans (male and female) in the first place.

And Elohim said, "**Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness**, and let them rule over the fish of the sea, and over the birds of the heavens, and over the livestock, and over all the earth and over all the creeping *creatures* that creep on the ground." (Genesis 1:26 TS2009 [bold added])

The human race was formed from the soil of the earth to be imagers of God. In other words, we were created to be a reflection in character and essence of our Creator. Adding to this, it is my opinion that

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humans were patterned after God's Son, the Word or Logos of creation, not only in character but also in appearance. Humans were created to reflect God's Son who came out from His Father as the firstborn of creation. When He did, He manifested as a spiritual-physical (spirit-animated) Son. When He declared: *Let there be*, He *logosed* into existence creation as the physical expression of the spirit that is God. Of course, all in accord with God's plan, the fall of the first man, Adam, tainted this expression.

The good news is that the last Adam, the Second Man, Jesus, re-created this through His resurrection and glorification in a new body, and re-created the destiny of the human race in order for God's ultimate purpose to be realized. Humans are now on track to become spirit-animated beings where the spirit and the physical (body; energized by spirit not by blood) unite as one. This is why Jesus taught His disciples (and us) to pray for God's will on earth as it is in heaven. Heaven and earth are destined for union, and as God's new creation, we are destined for this same union.

N.T. Wright, in his *Kingdom New Testament* translation, best captures our destiny.

But you don't get the **spirit-animated body** first; you get the **nature-animated** one, and get the spirit-animated one later. The first man is from the ground, and is made of the earth; the second man is from heaven. Earthly people are like the man of the earth; heavenly people are like the man from heaven. We have borne the image of man made of earth; we shall also bear the image of the man from heaven. (1 Corinthians 15:46-49 Kingdom-NT [bold added])

Paul truly captures God's plan from before the foundation of the world. The fall was no accident nor was it some unexpected anomaly. It was and is the plan of God. Adam's race was destined to occupy a nature-animated body so that it could one day be transformed into a spirit-animated body in the perfect image of God's Son – vessels perfected in love and being true, untainted imagers of God.

To be clear, Jesus went to the cross for this very purpose and, in so doing, He manifested the very nature of **God is love**. The cross was and still is the perfect expression of God's love for the world and His creation.

This is the battleground today. Is humanity going to be transformed by God's Son into spirit-animated bodies in His image or are they going to be transformed by evil men into what they call *transhumans*? Got news for them: God's Son wins because He has already won the war on the cross. This is simply a battle prior to the consummation of His victory. We need to be reminded of this consummation as given to us through Paul.

We are citizens of heaven, you see, and **we're eagerly waiting for the savior, the Lord, King Jesus, who is going to come from there**. Our present body is a shabby old thing, but **he's going to transform it so that it's just like his glorious body**. And he's going to do this by the power which makes him able to bring everything into line under his authority. (Philippians 3:20-21 Kingdom-NT [bold added])

Battle for Global Order

The next related battle that is raging in our day is one that involves the very order of the world's systems. The battle is our Creator's **divine order led by His spirit** versus **man's order absent God's spirit** (the temple of man without the holy spirit). It is the difference between light and dark, truth and lies, and good and evil. In some respects, we are seeing a replay of a scene that occurred in the first century between the

adversary and Jesus, only this time, it is being played out globally through men who see themselves as gods. They are children of the father of lies who will go the way of the adversary.

Again, the opponent (evil one; adversary; devil; false accuser) took Him along to an extremely high mountain range, and pointed out to Him **all the kingdoms** (reigns of the ordered system) **of the world and their glory** (splendor). Then it said to Him, "**I will give all these things to You**, if You would fall down and worship me." (Matthew 4:8-9 compilation)

The censorship of truth in our day is typical of darkness that seeks to hide or obliterate the truth. Through their actions, global elitists are no longer hiding their true agenda. The fact of the matter is that they are thrusting it in our face more and more every day. It is out in the open that they are driving toward a new world order built in their own, godless image. Two words stand out in explaining this new world order: **technocracy** and **transhumanism**. Without going into the details of these movements, there are some words to be on the lookout for that are part of this deception: climate change, green new deal, sustainable development, zero CO2, population control, health security, social justice, gender neutrality, social credits, Agenda 2030, World Economic Forum, and *physical-digital-biological*, to name a few. Again, you are referred to **Truth Under Siege**.

Here is the good news: the outcome of this battle has already been announced by the loud voices of heaven.

And the seventh messenger trumpets. And loud voices occurred in heaven, saying, "**The kingdom of this world became our Lord's and His Christ's, and He shall be reigning for the eons of the eons! Amen!**" (Revelation 11:15 CLV [bold added])

Surely, this is not a one-off announcement, but one that has resonated down through the centuries with King Jesus' resurrection and glorification at the right hand of His Father, who proclaimed:

"But as for Me, I have installed **My King** Upon Zion, My holy mountain." "I will surely tell of the decree of the LORD: He said to Me, 'You are **My Son**, Today I have begotten You. 'Ask of Me, and I will surely give the nations as Your inheritance, and the very ends of the earth as Your possession. (Psalm 2:6-8 NASB [bold added])

Like the voices of heaven, we must be the voices on earth proclaiming the truth about the one who is Truth. As ones maturing into sonship, we must stand on the side of the kingdom of our Lord. This battle is well underway in our day. **It is a battle of divine order versus man's technocratic order, or simply, God's order versus man's order**. Again, the good news is that when the dust settles and all the enemies are defeated and subjected to God's King, there will be only one order – the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ.

Let us hold to the big picture: This is a battle between the kingdoms of this world and the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ. See: **Kingdom of Our Lord: The Declaration**.

Battle for America

Finally, among the globalists, there is a perception that there is one nation on earth that stands in their way to achieving victory through a great global reset, which will lead to total control of the human

population. That nation is America! Consequently, to drive their agenda forward unhindered, there is a perception that America must be removed as the world's superpower and absorbed into a one-world order where national sovereignty and economic power is no longer welcomed. I purposely use the word *perception* because they don't realize that there is a kingdom that stands in their way that is immovable and indestructible. Of course, this speaks of the kingdom of God. To the extent that America stands for God's kingdom, she too stands in the way of this global agenda. The question is: Will America stand on God's side or go the way of the antichrist spirit of the world? If we choose God this day, the globalists' greatest fears will be realized.

Before proceeding, let it be known that I thank God quite often for living in such a great nation and I wouldn't choose any other place to be. We are not a perfect nation and we definitely have our problems, but taken as a whole, there is a lot for which to be thankful. Also, as I have written elsewhere, I believe America to be a nation by the providence of Almighty God and we are joined with other nations that grew out of descendants of the tribes of Israel that were dispersed among the nations starting around 721 BC as they began their long trek across Europe to the British Isles, North America, and elsewhere. Given this, we need to see America in light of the kingdom of God, meaning our loyalty must be, first, to God's kingdom. *Seek first My kingdom!* As Christians, we need to be **Kingdom-centric** and less America-centric. Everything else is secondary, including nationalism and patriotism. We can greatly appreciate, even love, what God has given us, but let us keep it in the proper perspective – that is, the kingdom of God must be first and foremost for those of us who belong to King Jesus. We are what we are by the grace of God and being subject to His kingdom is paramount.

Now, let's consider the national election for president that has not been officially certified, contrary to what the mainstream media that have become the censors of "truth" would have the nation believe. Recently, one commentator said that what's at stake is America either going into a **dark age** or into a **golden age**. Of course, one would have to explain the character of these two ages, which the commentator did not, but the obvious implication is that one would be bad and the other good. From a natural viewpoint, all of us would agree. But what about from a spiritual viewpoint? Two verses come to mind.

"I spoke to you in your prosperity; but you said, 'I will not listen!' This has been your practice from your youth, that you have not obeyed My voice. (Jeremiah 22:21 NASB [bold added])

I know how to get along with humble means, and I also know how to live in prosperity; in any and every circumstance I have learned the secret of being filled and going hungry, both of having abundance and suffering need. (Philippians 4:12 NASB [bold added])

Further elaboration is not needed, as I'm sure most everyone understands what the Lord spoke through Jeremiah and how Paul assessed outward or natural conditions. The answer for the Lord's people, regardless of the outward (dark age or golden age), is: ***I can do all things through Him who strengthens me*** (Philippians 4:13). We can easily lose this testimony, whether in trial (dark time) or not (golden time). Actually, prosperity is probably the most dangerous for the Lord's people, as it could lead hearts away from God, much like in Solomon's day. Given this, we should be more concerned over a golden age in which people forget the very source of the blessing of prosperity.

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These, and more, are all important points, but there is something much greater in play at this very moment. **America, the land of the free**, is at the forefront of a battle raging over **freedom versus bondage**. The global elitists must bring humanity into bondage to its movement in order to achieve their conquest of the world. America is the one nation on earth that was truly founded on the principle of freedom, and it is the one nation on earth that stands in the way of global bondage. This is what's at stake in the battle for America. If we fall in line with the globalists, then the rest of the world will follow. And, to be clear, the presidential election is a major part of this battle. I purposely use the expression *part of*, for other battles (resistance) will most likely be fought, depending on how the election turns out and what course the next administration (45th or 46th) takes. By the way, Biden campaigned on *Build Back Better* (the slogan of the global new order) and has openly announced that he is going to rejoin the Paris Climate Accord, the United Nations, the World Health Organization, and other entities that are part of the drive toward a technocratic global order – from which Trump removed America. These are all part of the battle.

Conclusion

Dear people of God, these are the major issues at work today. This is what's going on. But as I keep reminding – the good news is that **we are not only on the side of the Victor but we are in the Victor. The war was won on the cross and the victory manifested in the empty tomb**. Let us not forget this, and let us not get so caught in the weeds of the battle and the multitude of voices that attempt to explain it (whether they see it as a battle or not) to the point we become distracted from the very purpose of God in all this and from the next phase of His plan when His kingdom openly manifests on earth and the nations are introduced to their King.

It is time for the anointing, the spirit of truth, which resides in each and every new creation in Christ, to rise up. We are to prepare the way for King Jesus, who is coming soon. This is the [appointed time](#). We do this through the spirit of truth that has been given to us. How do we prepare the way? We do it by being imagers of Jesus in and to the world. By the way; we can't do this in our natural state but the spirit can and will do it. Walk by the spirit!

It is about *being* and not so much about doctrine or interpretation of scripture (although these have value). The world doesn't necessarily need to be told; it needs to see and this seeing must come through us who express Jesus and the love and peace of God to the world. Our expression comes through our daily experiences with Jesus and revelation of who and what He truly is.

It is time to awaken from our sleep and for our anointing to gush forth like rivers of living water. This is how the battle is won; and we can be optimistically and expectantly assured, it is won already. We are waiting for the open manifestation of this victory and the Presence of our Lord, King Jesus.
