### ***Repairing Crack in Wall: Large Hand Holding a Trowel (Vision)***

During October 1995, I had a vivid vision:

**I saw a very large hand holding a trowel. There was a large wall with a large crack in it that extended half way up the wall. The hand was patching the crack (filling it in) with the trowel.**

For those unfamiliar with the term, a *trowel* is a flat-bladed hand tool often used in masonry work to spread, shape, level, or smooth (fill) in concrete or mortar.

There seems to be two possibilities for interpreting this dream.

First, it could signify the repairing of the breach that occurred between Israel and Judah, a topic addressed in ***Until Shiloh Comes***. As presented in this article, Jesus is Shiloh, the one who brought the scepter of Judah into the house of Israel, thus repairing the breach. Shiloh arrived in the first century repairing the breach in an inaugural sense and is coming once again in the 21<sup>st</sup> century to finish (***consummate***) the task.

Second, it's possible this also relates to the Lord building His church, which includes mending her as she is split into so many fragments with so many names, ministries, denominations, etc.

Perhaps we see an indication of this in John who was mending or repairing the nets when he was called by the Lord. As the apostle of love and the longest living of the original apostles, John could be called a *mender of the church*, as well.

Going on from there He saw two other brothers, James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother, in the boat with Zebedee their father, ***mending their nets***; and He called them. (Matthew 4:21 NASB [bold italic added])

After all, John was the one who recorded Jesus' prayer to His Father in John 17. One of the primary themes of this prayer is oneness, a theme picked up by Paul as he taught there is only one body, one spirit, one Lord, and one God and Father of all (Ephesians 4:4-6).

Thus, the dream could signify the church is being mended by the hand of God through a people called to work with Him as menders. As our current age comes to a close with the arrival of King Jesus, I suggest we will see the crack of the church fully mended as a true oneness is experienced among the Lord's people – a oneness unlike any the world has seen in its entire history, and this oneness relates directly to the ***anointing***.

The two possibilities point to one thing: the arrival of King Jesus!
